GENDER AND HEALTH EDUCATION INITIATIVE 2023 Competition

Application Deadline: Noon, April 10, 2023

Amount: Variable - \$5,000 - \$15,000

The **Gender and Health Education Initiative** was established in 2004 to promote educational initiatives within the Faculty of Health Sciences which explore the relationships of gender and health.

The objectives of this initiative are to increase awareness of gender and health through:

- Fostering the development of educational resources within the Faculty of Health Sciences
- Providing opportunities for innovation in teaching and learning
- Encouraging interdisciplinary educational collaborations

Applications are invited from faculty, staff and students in the Faculty of Health Sciences for proposals to develop and/or implement educational initiatives. Staff and student proposals require a faculty supervisor.

Collaborative projects involving faculty and students and **interdisciplinary projects** crossing program and discipline boundaries are encouraged.

Examples of appropriate projects include, but are not limited to:

- Development of interactive educational computer modules
- Planning and staging a workshop, conference, or seminar addressing aspects of gender and health
- Determining better/best ways to deliver content around gender and health
- Evaluating the effectiveness of educative endeavours in gender and health.

Successful applicants will be asked to either provide a poster display or deliver a presentation at a future **May Cohen Lecture**, hosted by the McMaster University Gender & Health Education Initiative.
